COMMISSION ON ACCREDITATION FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES, INC.

The Elkhart County Sheriff's Department is scheduled for an assessment as part of a program to achieve re-accreditation by verifying it meets professional standards.

Administered by the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., (CALEA), the accreditation program requires agencies to comply with state-of-the art standards in four basic areas; policy and procedures, administration, operations, and support services.

As part of the assessment, sheriff employees and members of the community are invited to offer comments at a Public Information Session Thursday, September 8, 2011, at 5:30 p.m. The session will be conducted in Room 104 of the County Administration Building, 117 N. Second St., Goshen.

If for some reason an individual cannot speak at the Public Information Session, but would still like to provide comments to the Assessment Team, he/she may do so by telephone. The public may call 574-891-2305 on Wednesday, September 7, 2011, between the hours of 9:30a.m. – 11:30 a.m. Comments will be taken by the Assessment Team.

Telephone comments, as well as appearances at the Public Information Session, are limited to 10 minutes and must address the department's ability to comply with CALEA's standards.
